Invesco Announces Changes to Portfolio Management for Invesco Van Kampen Dynamic Credit Opportunities Fund, Invesco Van Kampen High Income Trust II, and Invesco Van Kampen Senior Income Trust

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HOUSTON, June 25, 2010 – Investment management decisions for Invesco Van Kampen Dynamic Credit Opportunities Fund (NYSE: VTA) (the Fund) are made by the investment management teams at Invesco Senior Secured Management, Inc.
